His role focused on terrorism prevention and he oversaw the internationally recognized behavior detection unit, an undercover team that tackles suspicious behavior looking for pre incident behaviors.

He is a recognized public speaker and lecturer who specializes in terrorism, organized crime and violence in places of religious worship. Simon has lectured at University of Minnesota, University of St. Thomas and presented at meetings held by Hennepin County Sheriff's office and the FBI. He serves on the board of directors for the FBI Minneapolis Citizens Academy (FBIMCAAAA) and is a committee member of InfraGard, a partnership between the FBI and private sector.

Church Security Awareness Training

CSAT is a Christian based security program designed to support places of worship by providing suspicious behavior and situational awareness training. Kingswood Director Simon Osamoh created the program after finding a need to better equip volunteers on security awareness after conducting training to churches on suspicious activity.

The program educates security and emergency response volunteers, and persons committed to protecting places of worship. Classes are taught by trained security professionals with experience from law enforcement to physical security. Biblical scripture is used to understand the connection between security and church ministry.

The curriculum

The six module classes provide the skills needed to effectively tackle suspicious activity providing a mixture of PowerPoint lectures, group discussions, videos and practical exercises.

- Module 1 - Security in Places of Worship
- Module 2 - Suspicious Activity in Places of Worship
- Module 3 - Pre Incident Surveillance
- Module 4 - Body Language and Communication
- Module 5 - Conversational Interviewing
- Module 6 - Explosive Awareness and Security Response Planning
